## Introduction to the 2017 S.O.L.D. Results

The ABA Standing Committee on Professional Regulation greatly appreciates the participation of U.S. lawyer disciplinary agencies in the annual ABA Survey on Lawyer Discipline Systems (S.O.L.D.). The S.O.L.D. questionnaire for 2017 was sent to 56 lawyer disciplinary agencies. Connecticut, Nevada, and New York:1<sup>st</sup> Department did not provide responses by the publication date. Massachusetts was unable to provide data this year, as it was undergoing an IT system upgrade. At the request of the State Bar of California, please derive data from these [public sources](#). The questionnaire is attached at the end of the survey.

The 2017 Survey results consist of ten charts arranged alphabetically by jurisdiction. Responses correspond to the questions as numbered on the questionnaire appended to the end of this document. Notes ("N") at the end of each chart include explanatory information provided by some jurisdictions. Where exact figures were not available, estimated figures were provided. The abbreviation "N/A" means that the data is not available or applicable. Medians and averages are shown where potentially meaningful. In most instances, averages have been rounded to the nearest whole number.
